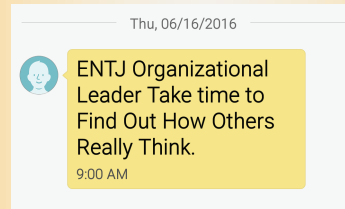
Video Strengths and Weaknesses Coaching

Nine five to ten minute videos coach personal potential specific to a user's profile. A user specific video based interpretive session provides users with in-depth understanding of their life purpose.



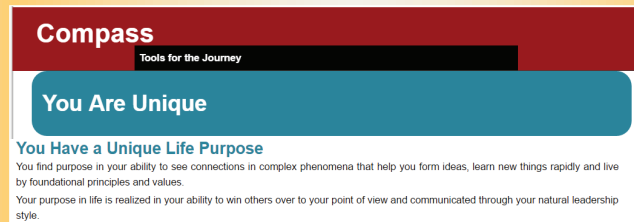
Daily or Weekly Mentoring Messages

Phone or Email Messages designed to remind users to make strengths based decisions are sent daily or weekly.



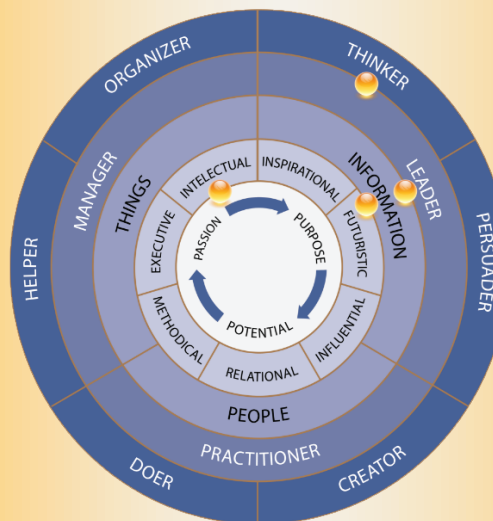
The Right Person for the Right Reason

Compass identifies where drive comes from including: Personal Orientation, Influences, Career Interests, and whether they are Leaders, Managers or Practitioners.

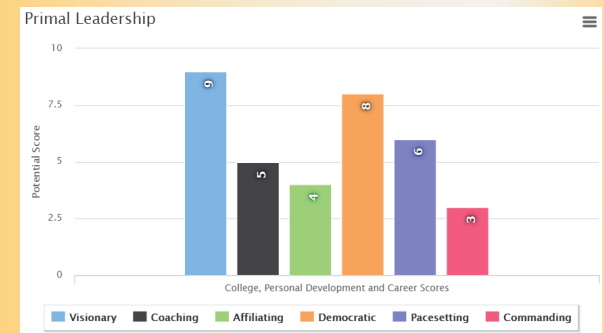
